III. GUIDELINES

Section 1. Filing and Submission of SALN on Time and to the Proper Official

Section 4. Ministerial Duty of the General Manager to issue Compliance Order

Section 5. Rules in Accomplishing the SALN Form

5.1.) Basic Information

- Spouses who are both public officers and employees shall have the option to file their SALN either jointly or separately.
