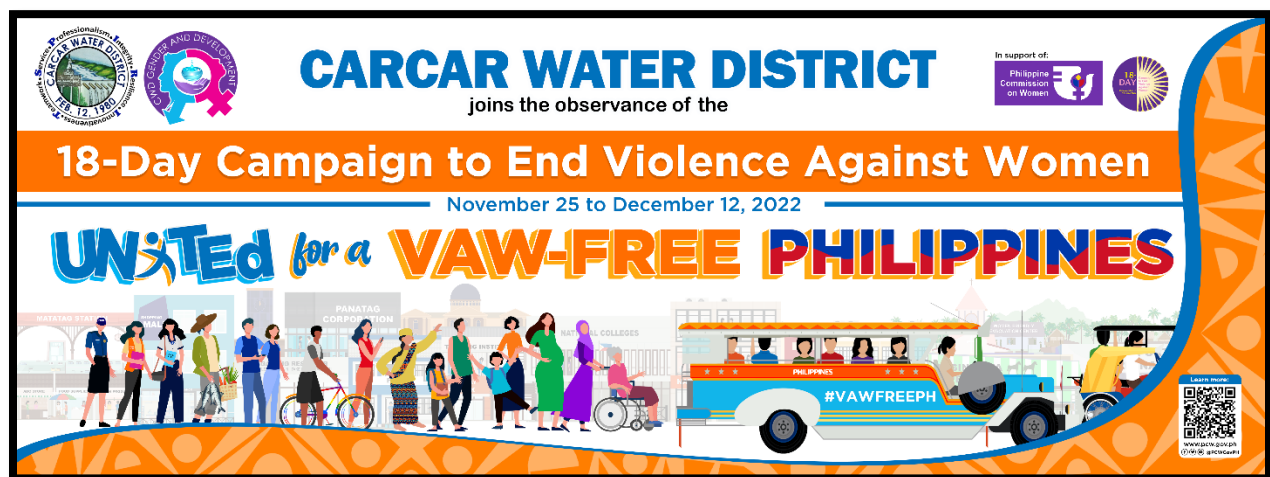


On November 25, 2022, Carcar Water District spearheaded by the CWD Gender and Development Committee, launches its 18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women and their Children (End VAWC). This is in support to the United Nations and The Philippine Commission on Women on their Program with the theme “United for a VAW-Free Philippines”. The 18-Day Campaign supports the Philippine government’s goal of protecting the human rights of women and girls by upholding its commitment to address all forms of gender-based violence as enshrined in the 1987 Constitution. Every November 25th of the year is celebrated as National Consciousness Day for the Elimination of VAWC wherein government agencies are mandated to raise awareness on the problem of violence and the elimination of all forms of violence against women and their children.

Within the 18-Day Campaign, Carcar Water District has lined up activities to increase awareness particularly for senior high school and college students. An orientation on the campaign to End VAWC will be held on Dec. 2 to be participated by different private schools in Carcar City. There will be an essay writing contest to be culminated on Dec. 12. December 2, 2022 – Orientation on the Campaign to End VAWC

December 7, 2022 – Deadline of submission of entries for the Essay Writing Contest

December 12, 2022 – Culmination of the campaign and awarding of winners for the Essay Writing Contest
